Dear Laura,

Thank you for your thorough presentation of the anticipated spending for Amherst Central School District with the available Smart Schools Bond dollars. We would like to propose that the remaining funds be used to purchase devices for students. While we understand that using the totality of the funds for that purpose is impractical due to the subsequent need to replace those devices in the future, the remaining funds are within a normal spending amount and would benefit all of the students in the district – not just those at the public schools.

The District expressed a need for funds totaling about \$635,000 for upgrades to security equipment, the cost of which is expanded to a conservative estimate of 1.25 times that amount to come up with a total project cost of roughly \$800,000. The District was given an allocation of \$1.043 million. If we subtract this project cost, we are left with \$224,000 that is not yet dedicated. Given that there are roughly 2900 students at Amherst Schools, 200 students at Christ the King, 200 students at St. Benedict's and 300 students at Park School, the remainder equates to about \$67.50 per student.

As a small school with limited resources at our disposal, \$13,500 would mean a lot to us and our ability to purchase devices for our students. We respectfully request that you consider this proposal.
