

**AUTHORIZATION AGREEMENT FOR ENROLLMENT IN THE
JUNIOR HONORS PRIVILEGE PROGRAM**

Junior Honors Privileges allow students the opportunity to earn the use of available high school facilities for worthwhile purposes during an unassigned free period. These purposes include: pursuit of academic assignments in the LMC, front courtyard, and cafeteria during non lunch periods. Junior Honors Privileges for an academic year may be granted at the start of the marking period or can be revoked at any time for reasons due to academic needs, behavioral circumstances or upon parent request. It is the student's responsibility to submit a completed application and waiver for approval to the **Dean of Students.**

Junior Honors Privileges may not be granted or will be revoked under, but not limited to, the following circumstances:

- A) Junior Honors Privilege at Amherst High School is an option for *qualified* 11th grade students. **To qualify for this program in September 2023, you must have a cumulative weighted average of 90 or above at the end of your Sophomore (10th grade) year.**
- B) These students also **must maintain a minimum grade of 90 or above in each course** in order to continue Junior Honors Privilege once it has been granted. Prior parental approval must be given before students can participate in the program. Those students who do not qualify will be assigned to a study hall.
- C) Juniors in violation of school rules as identified in the student handbook will be subject to loss of privileges for a minimum of 10 weeks.
- D) Juniors who fail to submit completed required school forms. These are, but not limited to: Student Health Emergency Data Form, Computer Use/Sexual Harassment Agreement, Photograph and Video Release and Code of Conduct Signature Consent Form.
- E) Juniors who have not made restitution for their books, lab keys or elevator keys from the previous school year.

Note:

- 1. Junior Honors Privileges are not a hall pass. All students must have a pass to be in the halls.
- 2. Students must report to their homeroom by 8:15am, regardless if their 1st period is unassigned. Also, students are required to remain on campus during all unassigned periods.
- 3. Students who lose Junior Honors Privileges will be expected to be in school and attend assigned study halls, unless an exception is granted by the Dean of Students. Privileges may be revoked by the parent or guardian at any time.
- 4. If Junior Honors Privilege is revoked, then the student must reapply for the next quarter.
